




We store rainwater in a big underground tank. Some people water using motor pumps but we use a bicycle. Bicycle is very useful for laundry and other things.












This is the train station and also the rental station for cars and bicycles. We can drop them off at any destinations and it makes us travel light.













We rented a different kind of bike on our way home.








Beautiful night sky, isn't it?
I heard that we couldn't see the Milky way in the cities in 21st century, but we can see it clearly now.


*Kids navigator
This navigator tells you where she/he is to your computer.



We have many fishing piers. Fishing is popular as one of the means of self-sufficiency. Beautiful sea, isn't it? I heard it used to be green and murky.





They look safer, right? Bamboo is flexible, withstands strong winds, and on top of that, it's light and strong. So it's perfect for windmill.


